5 Section 20. The following named amount of \$196,299, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 6 Capital Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State 7 Appellate Defender for expenses incurred in providing 8 assistance to trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section 9 10 10 of the State Appellate Defender Act.

Section 25. The following named amount, \$18,800, or so necessary, respectively, much thereof may be as appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

Section 30. The following named amount, \$20,000, or so may be necessary, respectively, much thereof as appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training Program.

Section 35. The following named amount, \$350,000, or so

- 2 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of
