1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The sum of \$64,200,000, or so much of that
- 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
- 6 Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging for funding the

- 8 (1) an additional \$1.70 per hour to be paid to vendors of

- 13 statewide minimum wage increase; and
