## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

```
Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding Section 8-307 as follows:
```

(220 ILCS 5/8-307 new)
Sec. 8-307. Estimated billing for public utility service; penalties for overcharge. A public utility that overcharges a residential customer $\$ 500$ or more, based on estimated meter reading, in any given billing period, including, but not limited to, monthly, bi-monthly, and semi-annual billing, must refund the overcharge, plus 5\% interest, to the customer within 30 days after that billing period.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
