SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 430/5-60 new

Amends the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act. Provides that if any State officer or employee of the executive or legislative branch is placed on administrative leave, either voluntarily or involuntarily, pending the outcome of a criminal investigation or prosecution and that officer or employee is removed from office or employment for one or more reasons directly related to that criminal matter, then the officer or employee is indebted to the State for all compensation and the value of all benefits received during the administrative leave and must forthwith pay the full amount to the State. As a matter of law, applies similar restrictions on officers and employees of units of local government and school districts. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Officials and Employees Ethics Act is
amended by adding Section 5-60 as follows:

Sec. 5-60. Administrative leave during pending criminal
 matter.

9 (a) If any officer or employee is placed on administrative leave, either voluntarily or involuntarily, pending the 10 outcome of a criminal investigation or prosecution and that 11 12 officer or employee is removed from office or employment for one or more reasons directly related to that criminal matter, 13 14 then the officer or employee is indebted to the State for all compensation and the value of all benefits received during the 15 16 administrative leave and must forthwith pay the full amount to 17 the State.

18 (b) As a matter of law and without the necessity of the 19 adoption of an ordinance or resolution under Section 70-5, if 20 any officer or employee of a governmental entity is placed on 21 administrative leave, either voluntarily or involuntarily, 22 pending the outcome of a criminal investigation or prosecution 23 and that officer or employee is removed from office or
