AN ACT concerning government officers and employees.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Officials and Employees Ethics Act is
 amended by adding Section 5-60 as follows:

Sec. 5-60. Administrative leave during pending criminal
8 matter.

9 (a) If any officer or government employee is placed on administrative leave, either voluntarily or involuntarily, 10 pending the outcome of a criminal investigation or prosecution 11 12 and that officer or government employee is removed from office or employment for one or more reasons directly related to that 13 14 criminal matter, then the officer or government employee is indebted to the State for all compensation and the value of all 15 benefits received during the administrative leave and must 16 17 forthwith pay the full amount to the State.

18 (b) As a matter of law and without the necessity of the 19 adoption of an ordinance or resolution under Section 70-5, if 20 any officer or government employee of a governmental entity is 21 placed on administrative leave, either voluntarily or 22 involuntarily, pending the outcome of a criminal investigation 23 or prosecution and that officer or government employee is HB4726 Engrossed - 2 - LRB095 16883 BDD 42926 b
<u>removed from office or employment for one or more reasons</u>
<u>directly related to that criminal matter, then the officer or</u>
<u>government employee is indebted to the governmental entity for</u>
<u>all compensation and the value of all benefits received during</u>
<u>the administrative leave and must forthwith pay the full amount</u>
<u>to the governmental entity.</u>
