### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.12a

from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.12a

Amends the School Code. Provides that a pupil who becomes non-resident during a grading period (instead of school term) shall not be charged tuition for the remainder of the grading period (instead of school term) in which he or she became a non-resident pupil, except that a pupil who began the school year as a resident pupil but becomes non-resident during that school year shall not be charged tuition for the remainder of the school year if he or she is graduating from high school that school year. Effective July 1, 2008.

1 AN ACT concerning education.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
10-20.12a as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.12a) (from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.12a)

Sec. 10-20.12a. Tuition for non-resident pupils. To charge non-resident pupils who attend the schools of the district tuition in an amount not exceeding 110% of the per capita cost of maintaining the schools of the district for the preceding school year.

Such per capita cost shall be computed by dividing the total cost of conducting and maintaining the schools of the district by the average daily attendance, including tuition pupils. Depreciation on the buildings and equipment of the schools of the district, and the amount of annual depreciation on such buildings and equipment shall be dependent upon the useful life of such property.

19 The tuition charged shall in no case exceed 110% of the per 20 capita cost of conducting and maintaining the schools of the 21 district attended, as determined with reference to the most 22 recent audit prepared under Section 3-7 which is available at 23 the commencement of the current school year. Non-resident

pupils attending the schools of the district for less than the 1 2 school term shall have their tuition apportioned; - however, pupils who become non-resident during a grading period school 3 term shall not be charged tuition for the remainder of the 4 grading period school term in which they became non-resident 5 pupils, except that a pupil who began the school year as a 6 7 resident pupil but becomes non-resident during that school year shall not be charged tuition for the remainder of the school 8 9 year if he or she is graduating from high school that school 10 year.

11 Unless otherwise agreed to by the parties involved and 12 where the educational services are not otherwise provided for, educational services for an Illinois student under the age of 13 14 21 in a residential program designed to correct alcohol or 15 other drug dependencies shall be provided by the district in 16 which the facility is located and financed as follows. The cost 17 of educational services shall be paid by the district in which the student resides in an amount equal to the cost of providing 18 19 educational services in a treatment facility. Payments shall be 20 made by the district of the student's residence and shall be 21 made to the district wherein the facility is located no less 22 than once per month unless otherwise agreed to by the parties. 23 (Source: P.A. 89-397, eff. 8-20-95; 90-649, eff. 7-24-98.)

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,25 2008.
