Amend House Bill 4762 on page 11, by 3 replacing lines 25 and 26 as follows: 4 "(o) A majority of Board members constitutes a quorum. A quorum is required for all Board"; and 5 6 on page 17, lines 2 and 3, by deleting "as established by 7 rule,"; and on page 18, immediately below line 5, by inserting the 8 9 following: "(d) Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that 10 may exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head 11 under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to 12 13 make or promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, 14

however, the Governor believes that rules are necessary to

implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of

the 95th General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to 1 2 the General Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House 3 and the Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the 4 General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 5 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this 6 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be 7 interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 8 9 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 10 explicitly given. For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, "rules" is given the meaning 11 contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative 12 13 Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" are given the 14 meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that such 15 definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 16 jurisdiction of the Governor."; and 17
