1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4836 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4836 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 4 5 adding Section 356z.11 as follows: 6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.11 new) 7 Sec. 356z.11. Individual and group accident and health insurance. When the term "individual and group accident and 8 health insurance" is used in this Code, unless otherwise 9 10 specified, it shall not apply to policies that cover dental care only, short-term travel, accident-only, limited, or 11 specified disease policies or to policies or contracts designed 12 13 for issuance to persons eligible for coverage under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, known as Medicare, or any other 14

similar coverage under State or federal governmental plans.

Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may

1 exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under 2 the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or 3 promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this 4 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the 5 Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th 6 General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to the General 7 Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the 8 9 Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General 10 Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 11 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this 12 13 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be 14 interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 15 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 16 explicitly given. For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, "rules" is given the meaning 17 contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative 18 Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" are given the 19 20 meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois 21 Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that such 22 definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 23 jurisdiction of the Governor.".
