Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding Section 356z.12 as follows:

Sec. 356z.12. Applicability of mandated benefits to supplemental policies. Unless specified otherwise, the following Sections of the Illinois Insurance Code do not apply to short-term travel, disability income, long-term care, accident only, or limited or specified disease policies, including dental-only and vision-only policies, or to policies or contracts designed for issuance to persons eligible for coverage under Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, known as Medicare: 356b, 356c, 356d, 356g, 356k, 356m, 356n, 356p, 356g, 356z.6, 356z.8, 367.2, 367.2-5, and 367e.

Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may

Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or

enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th 1 2 General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to the General 3 Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the 4 Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 5 6 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action 7 in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this 8 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be 9 interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 10 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 11 explicitly given. For the purposes of this amendatory Act of 12 the 95th General Assembly, "rules" is given the meaning 13 contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" are given the 14 meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois 15 16 Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that such 17 definitions apply to <u>agencies</u> or <u>agency</u> heads under the jurisdiction of the Governor. 18
