1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4998 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 4998, AS AMENDED, in 2 Section 5, by replacing subsections (a) and (b) of Sec. 3 4 11-503.5 with the following: "(a) A person commits distracted driving when he or she 5 6 operates a motor vehicle while (i) engaging in text messaging, (ii) reading a newspaper, book, magazine, or map, (iii) applying make-up, or (iv) changing clothes or tying a tie, and 8 the operation of the motor vehicle is in violation of a law or 9 ordinance governing the movement of vehicles. 10 (b) A law enforcement officer may charge a person with 11 12 distracted driving under this Section if the officer has stopped the person for any violation of a law or ordinance 13 14 governing the movement of vehicles and if the officer determines that the driver was driving while distracted; 15 however, the offense of distracted driving is not deemed to be 16 17 a violation of a law or ordinance governing the movement of

vehicles and may not be recorded on the driving record of the

1 driver of the vehicle.".
