Amend House Bill 5070 on page 3, by 2 3 inserting immediately below line 21 the following: 4 "Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under 5 6 the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or 7 promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this 8 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the 9 Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th 10 General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to the General 11 12 Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General 13 14 Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 15 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action in the General Assembly's discretion. 2	explicitly given. For the purposes of this Section, "rules" is
3	given the meaning contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois
4	Administrative Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head"
5	are given the meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of
6	the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that
7	such definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the
8	jurisdiction of the Governor.".
