7 Section 5. "AN ACT making appropriations" Public Act 95-
8 348, as vetoed, reduced, and restored, is amended by changing
9 Sections 240 and 255 of Article 360 as follows:

11 Sec. 240. The sum of \$205,000,000 ~~\$193,000,000~~, or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the

2 "Regional Transportation Authority Act", as amended.

4 Sec. 255. The following named sums, or so much thereof

6 Public Transportation Fund to the Department of
7 Transportation for operating assistance grants to provide a

10 78-1109, as amended:
