1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5285 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 5285, on page 4, by replacing lines 2 through 10 with the following: 3 "(215 ILCS 5/356z.11 new) 4 Sec. 356z.11. Dependent students; medical leave of 5 absence. A group or individual policy of accident and health 6 7 insurance or managed care plan amended, delivered, issued, or renewed after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 8 95th General Assembly must continue to provide coverage for a 9 dependent college student who takes a medical leave of absence 10 11 or reduces his or her course load to part-time status because 12 of a catastrophic illness or injury. 13 Continuation of coverage under this Section is subject to 14 all of the policy's terms and conditions applicable to those forms of insurance. Continuation of insurance under the policy 15 16 shall terminate 12 months after notice of the illness or injury

or until the coverage would have otherwise lapsed pursuant to

10 <u>State or federal governmental plans."</u>.
