AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5288

AMENDMENT NO. $\qquad$ . Amend House Bill 5288 on page 5, by inserting after line 25 the following:
"(k-1) At an intersection equipped with an automated traffic law enforcement system, the yellow light change interval must be not less than 3 seconds.
(k-2) No person shall be charged with a traffic violation or be issued a written notice of violation, as a result of an automated traffic law enforcement system, unless the entire vehicle crosses the stop bar marked on the pavement.
(k-3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection (k-3), an intersection may not be equipped with an automated traffic law enforcement system unless the following requirements have been met:
(1) The county or municipality having jurisdiction has determined that the intersection has a high accident rate. Before such a determination is made, the county or municipality must have performed or caused to be performed
an evaluation of accident rates for a 6-month period. (2) The county or municipality having jurisdiction has, for a 3-month period, used strobe lights in the red lenses of all traffic signals at the intersection in an attempt to decrease the accident rate without the use of an automated traffic law enforcement system.
(3) All roads converging at the intersection are controlled by traffic signals mounted on mast arms.

This subsection $(k-3)$ does not apply to counties and municipalities that were authorized to operate automated traffic law enforcement systems before the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly.".
