1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5343

2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 5343, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 4 1, on page 12, by inserting immediately below line 12 the 5 following: "(i) Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that 6 7 may exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head 8 under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to 9 make or promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, 10 however, the Governor believes that rules are necessary to 11 12 implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to 13 14 the General Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the 15 16 General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 17 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action

in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this

1 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be 2 interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 3 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise explicitly given. For the purposes of this Section, "rules" is 4 5 given the meaning contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" 6 7 are given the meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that 9 such definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 10 jurisdiction of the Governor.".
