2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
22-27 as follows:

Sec. 22-27. World War II, and Korean Conflict, and Vietnam
<u>Conflict</u> veterans; diplomas.

9 (a) Upon request, the school board of any district that 10 maintains grades 10 through 12 may award a diploma to any 11 honorably discharged veteran who:

(1) served in the armed forces of the United States
during World War II, or the Korean Conflict, or the Vietnam
<u>Conflict</u>;

15 (2) resided within an area currently within the 16 district;

17 (3) left high school before graduating in order to18 serve in the armed forces of the United States; and

(4) has not received a high school diploma.

2 Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may 3 exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or 4 5 promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the 6 Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or 7 enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th 8 9 General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to the General 10 Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the 11 Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General 12 Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action 13 14 in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be 15 16 interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 17 explicitly given. For the purposes of this amendatory Act of 18 19 the 95th General Assembly, "rules" is given the meaning contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative 20 Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" are given the 21 22 meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois 23 Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that such 24 definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 25 jurisdiction of the Governor.
