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AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section 5 3-5047 as follows:

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(55 ILCS 5/3-5047 new)

7 Sec. 3-5047. Removal of personal information. Upon request 8 by any person, the recorder shall redact or remove that 9 person's social security number, employer taxpayer identification number, driver's license number, State 10 identification number, passport number, checking account 11 number, savings account number, credit card number, debit card 12 number, or personal identification (PIN) code from any internet 13 14 website maintained by the recorder or used by the recorder to display public records. The request must be made in writing and 15 delivered by mail, facsimile, electronic transmission, or in 16 17 person to the office of the recorder. The request must specify the personal information to be redacted and identify the 18 19 document that contains the personal information.

20 Within 12 months after the effective date of this 21 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly all county 22 recorders that publicly display records on an Internet website must submit a written policy, including a timeline, to their 23

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respective county boards providing for the redaction of social 1 2 security numbers from all records publicly displayed on the 3 website. Any county recorder that launches a website on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 95th 4 5 General Assembly shall develop and implement a policy providing for the removal of all social security numbers from all records 6 7 prior to the public display of those records on the website, 8 and must file a copy of the policy with the county board of 9 that county. Policies pertaining to the removal of social 10 security numbers from records to be posted on the internet 11 shall be made available to all employees of a county recorder. 12 No person or entity shall include an individual's social security number in a document that is prepared and presented 13 14 for recording with a county recorder. This Section shall not apply to (i) State or federal tax liens, certified copies of 15 16 death certificates, or other documents required by law to 17 contain personal identifying information or (ii) documents that were executed by an individual prior to the effective date 18 19 of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly.

20 <u>County recorders shall not be liable for any claims arising</u>
21 <u>from unintentional or inadvertent violations of this Section.</u>

Section 10. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.32 as follows:

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(30 ILCS 805/8.32 new)

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1	Sec. 8.32. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
2	of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
3	implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
4	the 95th General Assembly.
