1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5731 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 5731, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 4 2, as follows: on page 3, immediately below line 23, by inserting the 5 6 following: "(f) Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that 7 may exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head 8 under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to 9 make or promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions 10 11 of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the Governor believes that rules are necessary to 12 13 implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to 14 15 the General Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House 16 and the Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the

General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those

1 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action 2 in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this 3 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be 4 interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 5 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 6 explicitly given. For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, "rules" is given the meaning 7 contained in Section <u>1-70 of the Illinois Administrative</u> 8 9 Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" are given the 10 meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of the Illinois 11 Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that such definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 12 13 jurisdiction of the Governor.".
