1 promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the 2 Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or 3 4 enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th 5 General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to the General Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and 6 Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General 7 Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 8 9 suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action 10 in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this 11 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other 12 13 Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise 14 explicitly given. For the purposes of this Section, "rules" is 15 given the meaning contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head" 16 are given the meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of 17 the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that 18 such definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the 19 20 jurisdiction of the Governor.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22 becoming law.".
