1 AN ACT concerning land.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State of Illinois owns the following
- 5 described real estate:
- 6 THE SOUTH 20 ACRES OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED TRACT:
- 7 THE WEST 1,024.24 FEET OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST
- 8 QUARTER OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST OF THE
- 9 2ND PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN EXCEPT THE WEST 33' OF EVEN WIDTH
- 10 THEREOF.
- 11 ALSO BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS BEGINNING AT THE
- 12 SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF
- 13 SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST OF THE 2ND
- 14 PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN; THENCE NORTH 90 DEGREES 00 MINUTES 00
- 15 SECONDS EAST (ASSUMED BEARING), ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID
- 16 EAST HALF, 33 FEET TO THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE NORTH
- 17 00 DEGREES 10 MINUTES 52 SECONDS EAST, 878.90 FEET; THENCE
- NORTH 90 DEGREES 00 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST, 991.24 FEET;
- 19 THENCE SOUTH 00 DEGREES 10 MINUTES 52 SECONDS WEST, 878.90 FEET
- TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID EAST HALF; THENCE SOUTH 90 DEGREES 00
- 21 MINUTES 00 SECONDS WEST ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE 991.24 FEET TO

- 1 THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING. BEING ALL SITUATED IN PARIS
- 2 TOWNSHIP, EDGAR COUNTY, ILLINOIS AND CONTAINING 20.00 ACRES.
- 3 THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PROPERTY IS SUBJECT TO A DEDICATED RIGHT OF
- 4 WAY FOR PUBLIC ROAD AND PUBLIC UTILITY PURPOSES OVER THE SOUTH
- 5 45 FEET OF EVEN WIDTH THEREOF. AS RECORDED IN BOOK 12 OF
- 6 EASEMENTS, PAGE 92 AND DATED SEPTEMBER 6, 1990 OF THE RECORDS
- 7 OF EDGAR COUNTY, ILLINOIS.
- 8 Section 10. Upon the payment of the sum of \$1 to the State
- 9 of Illinois, and subject to the conditions set forth in Section
- 10 10 of this Act, the Director of Corrections, on behalf of the
- 11 State of Illinois and all State Agencies, must convey by
- 12 quitclaim deed all right, title, and interest of the State of
- 13 Illinois in and to the Ed Jenison Work Camp located in Edgar
- 14 County, Illinois to the City of Paris as described in Section
- 15 5.
- 16 Section 15. The quit claim deed shall state on its face and
- 17 be subject to the condition that if the property is no longer
- 18 used for public purposes, then title shall revert without
- 19 further action to the State of Illinois.
- 20 Section 20. The Director of Corrections shall obtain a
- 21 certified copy of this Act within 60 days after its effective
- date, and shall record the certified document in the recorder's

- office in the county in which the land is located. 1
- 2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law. 3
