1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5912

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 5912 on page 3, by 3 replacing lines 19 through 22 with the following:

"(f) The corporate authorities of a municipality may adopt ordinances or resolutions allowing all-terrain vehicles to be operated on roadways under their jurisdiction, subject to the following restrictions: (i) all-terrain vehicles may be operated on roadways under this subsection (f) only by persons holding a valid Illinois driver's license; and (ii) all-terrain vehicles operated on roadways under this subsection (f) must be equipped with brakes, a steering apparatus, tires, a rearview mirror, a headlight that emits a white light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the front, a tail lamp that emits a red light visible from at least 100 feet from the rear, brake lights, and turn signals. When operated on a roadway, an all-terrain vehicle shall have its headlight and tail lamps
