A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board  
8 of the Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet  
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending  
10 June 30, 2009:

11 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:

12	For Personal Services, including payment	
13	to the university for personal services	
14	costs incurred during the fiscal year	
15	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic	
16	personnel for personal services rendered	
17	during the academic year 2008-2009 .....	631,147,964
18	For State Contributions to Social	
19	Security, for Medicare .....	9,886,074
20	For Group Insurance .....	24,893,200
21	For Contractual Services .....	44,910,282
22	For Travel .....	327,561

1	For Commodities .....	2,741,972

15 Section 10. The sum of \$2,445,500, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention  
17 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
18 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service  
19 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the  
20 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment  
21 to the University for personal services and related costs  
22 incurred.

23 Section 15. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
2 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
3 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in  
4 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

5 Section 20. The sum of \$89,700, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Toxic Pollution  
7 Prevention Fund to the University of Illinois for its  
8 ordinary and contingent expenses.

9 Section 25. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public  
11 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and  
12 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito  
13 Abatement.

14 Section 30. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire  
16 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and  
17 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and  
18 abatement.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$149,000, or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Natural Areas  
21 Acquisition Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and

1 expenses related to or in support of the Lost Mound Field  
2 Station.

3 Section 40. The sum of \$472,100, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste  
5 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary  
6 and contingent expenses.

7 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July  
8 1, 2008.
