# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 1 Section 10. The sum of \$000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 3 to the Department of Military Affairs for a Lincoln's
- 4 Challenge satellite campus which must be no closer than a 100
- 5 mile radius from the existing program.
- 6 Section 15. The sum of \$11,500,000, or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support
- 8 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military
- 9 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to Army
- 10 National Guard Facilities operations and maintenance as
- 11 provided for in the Cooperative Funding Agreements, including
- 12 costs in prior years.
- 13 Section 20. The sum of \$415,000, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support
- 15 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military
- 16 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to the
- 17 Bartonville and Kankakee armories for operations and
- 18 maintenance according to the Joint-Use Agreement, including
- 19 costs in prior years.
- Section 25. The sum of \$43,000, or so much thereof as
- 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

- 1 Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Facilities
- 2 Division for rehabilitation and minor construction at
- 3 armories and camps.
- 4 Section 30. The sum of \$7,400, or so much thereof as may
- 5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 6 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant
- 7 General Division for expenses related to the care and
- 8 preservation of historic artifacts.
- 9 Section 35. The sum of \$1,432,000, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs
- 11 Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of
- 12 the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other
- 13 programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be
- 14 made available from public or private sources.
- 15 Section 40. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military
- 17 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs
- 18 Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of
- 19 grants to persons or families of persons who are members of
- 20 the Illinois National Guard or Illinois residents who are
- 21 members of the armed forces of the United States and who have
- 22 been called to active duty as a result of the September 11,

- 1 2001 terrorist attacks, including costs in prior years.
- 2 Section 45. The sum of \$000, or so much thereof as may
- 3 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- 4 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant
- 5 General Division for costs and expenses related to or in
- 6 support of a public safety shared services center.
- 7 Section 50. No contract shall be entered into or
- 8 obligation incurred for any expenditures made from an
- 9 appropriation herein made in Section 25 until after the
- 10 purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the
- 11 Governor.
- 12 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 13 1, 2008.
