Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 40. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants to state agencies and units of local government, to include operational
- 6 activities and programs undertaken by the Authority, in
- 7 support of Federal Crime Bill Initiatives.
- Section 45. The sum of \$4,500,000, or so much thereof as 8 9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Juvenile 10 Accountability Incentive Block Grant Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards 11 12 and grants to state agencies and units of local government, including operational expenses of the Authority in support of 13 the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant program. 14
- Section 50. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Criminal Justice Information Authority for costs and expenses related to a capital punishment reform study committee.
- Section 55. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Criminal Justice Information Authority for costs and

- 1 expenses related to the Downstate Innocence Project.
- 2 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 3 1, 2008.
