2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$865,100, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging as follows:

7	For Administrative Expenses of the	
8	Red Tape Cutter Program	9,800
9	For Grants for Suburban Area Agency	
10	on Aging for the Red	
11	Tape Cutter Program	251,700
12	For Grants for Chicago Department on Aging	
13	for the Red Tape Cutter Program	603,600

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
