1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the 7 objects and purposes and in the amounts set forth as follows: 8 GRANTS-IN-AID 9 10 For Bonus Payments to War Veterans and Peacetime 11 For Providing Educational Opportunities for 12 13 Children of Certain Veterans, as provided 14 For Cartage and Erection of Veterans' 15 Headstones, including Prior Years Claims650,000 16 Total \$911,500 17 Section 20. The following named sum, or so much thereof 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois 19 Affordable Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Veterans' 20 Affairs for the object and purpose and in the amount set 21

- 2 For Specially Adapted Housing for Veterans223,000
- 3 Section 25. The sum of \$842,500, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 5 Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the payment
- of scholarships to students who are dependents of Illinois
- 7 resident military personnel declared to be prisoners of war,
- 8 missing in action, killed or permanently disabled, as
- 9 provided by law.
- Section 30. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
- 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 12 Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for costs
- 13 associated with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder Outpatient
- 14 Counseling Program.
- 15 Section 40. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
- 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military
- 17 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for
- 18 the payment of benefits authorized under the Survivor's
- 19 Compensation Act.
- Section 50. The sum of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Veterans

- 1 Assistance Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for
- 2 making grants, funding additional services, or conducting
- 3 additional research projects relating to veterans' post
- 4 traumatic stress disorder; veterans' homelessness; the health
- 5 insurance cost of veterans; veterans' disability benefits,
- 6 including but not limited to, disability benefits provided by
- 7 veterans service organizations and veterans assistance
- 8 commissions or centers; and the long-term care of veterans.

9 ARTICLE 999

- 10 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 11 1, 2008.
