1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6586

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6586, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
8 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
9 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

10 GRANTS

11 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

12 For Chicago Fire Department Training Program1,950,300

13 For payment to local governmental agencies

14 which participate in the State Training

1	Programs	950,000
2	For Regional Training Grants	475,000
3	For payments in accordance with	
4	Public Act 93-0169	<u>15,000</u>
5	Total	\$3,390,300

6 Section 10. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
8 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available
9 for the development of new fire districts.

10 Section 15. The sum of \$522,500, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
12 Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
13 a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs
14 incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage
15 Program.

16 Section 20. The sum of \$498,500, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
18 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
19 available for the development of local government fire
20 prevention.

21 Section 25. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
2 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
3 available for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS
4 administration.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$675,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
7 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
8 available for the NITE project.

9 Section 35. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Cigarette Fire Safety
11 Standard Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the
12 purpose of fire safety and prevention programs.

13 ARTICLE 999

14 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect
15 July 1, 2008."
