2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. "An Act concerning appropriations", Public Act
5 95-731, approved with items vetoed and reduced on July 9,
6 2008, is amended by changing Section 5 of Article 34 as
7 follows:

8 (P.A. 95-731, Art. 34, Sec. 5)

9 Sec. 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
11 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
12 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of
13 Revenue:
