HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT HC0019

Introduced 2/23/2007, by Rep. Jack D. Franks

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. V, Sec. 1 ILCON Art. V, Sec. 3 ILCON Art. V, Sec. 7 ILCON Art. V, Sec. 17 ILCON Art. V, Sec. 18

Proposes to amend the Executive Article of the Illinois Constitution. Eliminates the Offices of the Comptroller and Treasurer. Provides instead for a single Comptroller of the Treasury. Provides that the Comptroller of the Treasury shall (i) maintain the State's central fiscal accounts and order payments into and out of the funds held by him or her, (ii) be responsible for the safekeeping and investment of monies and securities deposited with him or her, and for their disbursement upon his or her order, and (iii) have the duties and powers that may be prescribed by law. No Comptroller or Treasurer shall be elected in 2010 and thereafter. Effective otherwise upon conclusion of the terms of the Comptroller and the Treasurer elected in 2006.

14	SECTION 1. OFFICERS
15	The Executive Branch shall include a Governor, Lieutenant
16	Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, and
17	Comptroller of the Treasury Comptroller and Treasurer elected
18	by the electors of the State. They shall keep the public
19	records and maintain a residence at the seat of government

- 2 To be eligible to hold the office of Governor, Lieutenant

- 5 United States citizen, at least 25 years old, and a resident of
- this State for the three years preceding his or her election. 6

- SECTION 7. VACANCIES IN OTHER ELECTIVE OFFICES 9
- 10 If the Attorney General, Secretary of State, or Comptroller

- office by appointment. The appointee shall hold office until 1.3
