1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Citizen participation in the electoral process is 3 the cornerstone of our American democracy; and

- WHEREAS, Unfortunately, the rate of voter turnout for elections in this country has declined over the years and is lower than the rate enjoyed by some other democracies around the world; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Germany and Italy, for instance, have experienced 9 a growth in their percentages of voter participation since 10 making their election days national holidays; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Making each federal election day a national 12 holiday in the United States would make it easier for Americans 13 to get to the polls, and election authorities would find a 14 greater number of election workers and accessible buildings 15 available; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
 NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
 urge the United States Congress to enact, and the President to
 approve, legislation making each federal election day a
 national holiday; and be it further

RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be presented to the President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, and each member of the Illinois congressional delegation.
