HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, School impact fees are an ongoing problem in many Illinois communities that are experiencing high population growth; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois School Impact Fee Task Force was created by House Resolution 1006 of the 93rd General Assembly for the purpose of studying impact fees in Illinois; the Task Force was unable to complete its work in the allotted time frame; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that there is established the Illinois School Impact Fee Task Force for the purposes set forth in House Resolution 1006 of the $93 r d$ General Assembly; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall consist of the following members: (i) 2 members of the House of Representatives, or their designees, appointed by the Speaker of the House, one of whom shall serve as co-chairperson of the Task Force; (ii) 2 members of the House of Representatives, or their designees, appointed by the Minority Leader of the House, one of whom shall serve as co-chairperson of the Task Force; (iii) 2 members of the public, one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House and one of whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader of the House; (iv) 2 members appointed by an association that represents school boards; (v) 2 members appointed by an association that represents school administrators; (vi) 2 members appointed by an association that represents home builders; (vii) 2 members appointed by an association that represents realtors; (viii) one member appointed by an association that represents municipalities; (ix) one representative of municipal government; and (x) one representative of county government; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the School Impact Fee Task Force shall present a report of its findings to the General Assembly by January 1, 2009 .
