1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Adlai Ewing Stevenson II, born on February 5, 3 1900, was raised in Bloomington, Illinois, attended schools in 4 Bloomington and Normal, and worked at the Daily Pantagraph; and

WHEREAS, Adlai Stevenson II served his country in numerous government posts, including attendance at the 1945 San Francisco Conference that founded the United Nations, his election in 1948 to the office of Governor of the State of Illinois, and his appointment as United States Ambassador to the United Nations from 1961 until the time of his death in 1965, after which he was interred in his family plot at Evergreen Cemetery in Bloomington; and

WHEREAS, Adlai Stevenson II was tremendously admired for the eloquence with which he campaigned for the office of President of the United States in 1952 and 1956, saying "Let's talk sense to the American people. Let's tell them the truth, that there are no gains without pains, that we are now on the eve of great decisions, not easy decisions, like resistance when you are attacked, but a long, patient, costly struggle which alone can assure triumph over the great many enemies of man - war, poverty, and tyranny - and the assaults upon human dignity which are the most grievous consequences of each."; and
