WHEREAS, The State of Illinois continues to 2 face a 3 multi-billion dollar operating deficit, spiraling pension 4 costs, and growing liabilities that have exceeded annual 5 revenue growth; and 6 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has a number of executive 7 aircraft, including four \$5 million King Air Turboprops and two 8 \$4 million executive helicopters; and 9 WHEREAS, The Illinois Auditor General recently reported 10 that it costs the State of Illinois \$9.81 per nautical mile to operate the executive aircraft; and 11 12 WHEREAS, It costs the State of Illinois millions of dollars 13 annually to own, maintain, and staff the fleet of executive aircraft; therefore, be it 14

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we encourage the Governor and the Governor's Office of Management and Budget to conduct a study to examine the possibility of selling or leasing the executive air fleet as a means to save money for the State of Illinois; and be it further
