2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are pleased to congratulate Cornelius 4 Bergbower of Bluford, formerly of Newton, on the occasion of 5 his 79th birthday, May 26, 2008; and

6 WHEREAS, He was born in 1929; in October of 1950 he 7 enlisted in the United States Air Force; after attending 8 Aircraft Engine School in Wichita Falls, Texas, he was assigned 9 to the 305th Bombardment Wing near Tampa, Florida; and

WHEREAS, He later became an Aircraft Instrument Specialist at Chanute Air Force Base in Rantoul; he was instrumental in working with the phase-out of the B-29 Superfortress and the introduction of the new B-47 Stratojet; the Stratojet was a model for commercial airliners and became a vital part of the Korean conflict; and

WHEREAS, Upon his discharge in 1953 Mr. Bergbower went to work for the Illinois Central Railroad, where he worked for over 30 years serving as a lineman and Communications Director for the Southern Illinois branch of the railroad; and

WHEREAS, He became a collector of Model T parts as well as other Ford parts and cars while working for the railroad; he

- 1 later started Berg's Antique Auto Parts to manufacture Model A
- 2 and T radiators, water pumps, and pedal pads for people across
- 3 the nation; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Cornelius Bergbower was also the proud owner of a
- 5 1923 Rickenbacker Opera Coupe, named for Captain Eddie
- 6 Rickenbacker, a fighter ace during World War I; therefore, be
