15 WHEREAS, Katie's junior year saw her volleyball team become 16 State champions, number one in the nation, and GCAC champions; 17 her basketball team were again GCAC champions; during her 18 senior year she set a kill record for a State match at 28 19 kills; her volleyball team was second in the State and both her 20 volleyball and basketball teams were GCAC champions; and

11 WHEREAS, Since 2003 she has been an assistant coach at the 12 University of Illinois in Chicago; therefore, be it
