HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Record-breaking rainfall from September 12, 2008 to September 14, 2008 caused widespread property damage to homeowners and owners of commercial and industrial property throughout Illinois, including the greater Chicago area; and

WHEREAS, Current federal law requires the State of Illinois' designated coordinator of emergency support services, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA), to complete a preliminary damage assessment before an application can be made to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to have affected Illinois counties declared federal disaster areas; and

WHEREAS, The declaration by FEMA that an affected area is a federal disaster area is a necessary triggering event that must take place if the individuals and businesses that have suffered flooding damage are to be eligible for federal disaster assistance; and

WHEREAS, The preliminary damage assessment has been completed by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and a letter was sent by Governor Rod Blagojevich relaying the findings of that assessment and asking the President of the United States to declare the damaged counties as federal

- disaster areas on September 24, 2008; and
- 2 WHEREAS, As damage repairs continue at the expense of those
- 3 persons affected by loss, it becomes more difficult for
- 4 potential federal aid to "make whole" those individuals who
- 5 have suffered a loss; therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 7 NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we
- 8 urge the President of the United States to declare the affected
- 9 Illinois counties as federal disaster areas; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 11 presented to the President of the United States.
