- solicitor has a prior or existing business relationship;
- 13 (3) a telephone call placed on behalf of any political,
- 14 charitable, <u>public policy</u>, public opinion polling,
- 15 research survey, or radio or television broadcast rating
- organization.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), all
- calls made by an autodialer must be made in compliance with the
- requirements of subsection (d) of Section 15.
