13	committed person that are in possession of a county sheriff at
14	the time a person is committed to the Illinois Department of
15	Corrections shall be forwarded to the Department.
16	(b) The Department shall retain the government issued

1	identification documents, keys, and prescription drugs of a
2	committed person at the institution in which the person is
3	incarcerated and shall ensure that the documents, keys, and
4	prescription drugs are forwarded to any institution to which
5	the person is transferred.
6	(c) The government issued identification documents, keys,
7	and prescription drugs of a committed person shall be made
8	available to the person upon discharge from the Department.".
