 12 subsection (a) does not apply to a person who unintentionally
- fails to pay attorney registration fees established by Supreme
- 14 Court Rule.
- 15 (b) A person who falsely represents himself or herself to
- be a public officer or a public employee or an official or
- 17 employee of the federal government commits a Class \underline{A} \underline{B}
- 18 misdemeanor. If the false representation is made in furtherance
- of the commission of a felony, the penalty for a violation of
- this subsection (b) is a Class 4 felony.
