Amends the Wildlife Code. Prohibits the taking, with knowledge, of any albino or all-white deer, which is entirely white except for the hooves, tarsal glands, head or part of the head, in this State at any time.

- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 2.24 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.24) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.24)
- 7 Sec. 2.24. It shall be unlawful to take or possess deer in
- 8 this State, except in compliance with the provisions of
- 9 Sections 2.25, 2.26, and 3.23 and the administrative rules
- 10 issued under the provisions of those Sections. It is unlawful
- 11 for any person to knowingly take any <u>albino or</u> all-white
- 12 whitetail deer, which is entirely white except for the hooves,
- 13 tarsal glands, head, or part of the head, (Odocoileus
- 14 virginianus) in this State at any time.
