20 ILCS 605/605-980 new

Amends the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that the Department shall establish and administer a program to make grants to municipalities for urban preservation and redevelopment and for green technology.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

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1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section 605-980 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 605/605-980 new)
 - Sec. 605-980. Smart cities grant program. Subject to appropriation, the Department shall establish and administer a program to make grants to municipalities for urban preservation and redevelopment as well as green technology. The Department shall work in cooperation with local municipalities in order to provide funds to meet the municipalities' identified public infrastructure and urban improvement needs.

"Identified public infrastructure and urban improvement needs" include plans adopted by the municipality that have the following elements: an assessment of all public facilities and services, including, but not limited to, roads and other transportation facilities, sewers, schools, parks and open space, and fire and police services. Any municipality that is approved for grant moneys under this Section must develop a 5-year plan for the replacement and expansion of existing public facilities or the construction of any new facilities

- 1 that are required to meet expected growth and economic development. The plan shall be reviewed by the Department. The 2 3 plan must include a projection of when and where those facilities will be required and an assessment of the 4 anticipated costs for replacement, expansion, or construction 5 6 of public facilities. 7 Municipalities receiving grant moneys under this Section are encouraged to use local small businesses within the 8
- 9 municipality whenever possible.
