2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Economic
Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
amended by adding Section 605-980 as follows:

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(20 ILCS 605/605-980 new)

Sec. 605-980. Smart cities grant program. Subject to 8 9 appropriation, the Department may establish and administer a 10 program to make grants to municipalities for urban preservation and redevelopment as well as green technology. The Department 11 12 shall work in cooperation with local municipalities in order to provide funds to meet the municipalities' identified public 13 14 infrastructure and urban improvement needs. The program shall be permissive and shall be subject to appropriation by the 15 16 General Assembly.

17 <u>"Identified public infrastructure and urban improvement</u> 18 <u>needs" include plans adopted by the municipality that have the</u> 19 <u>following elements: an assessment of all public facilities and</u> 20 <u>services, including, but not limited to, roads and other</u> 21 <u>transportation facilities, sewers, schools, parks and open</u> 22 <u>space, and fire and police services. Any municipality that is</u> 23 <u>approved for grant moneys under this Section must develop a</u>

The plan shall be reviewed by the Department. The plan must include a projection of when and where those 5 6 facilities will be required and an assessment of the anticipated costs for replacement, expansion, or construction 7 of public facilities. 8 Municipalities receiving grant moneys under this Section 9 are encouraged to use local small businesses within the 10

11 municipality whenever possible.
