1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 284 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 284 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by adding 4 Section 3.5 as follows: 5 6 (225 ILCS 10/3.5 new) 7 Sec. 3.5. Group homes for adolescents diagnosed with 8 autism. (a) Subject to appropriation, the Department of Human 9 10 Services, Developmental Disabilities Division, shall provide for the establishment of 3 children's group homes for 11 adolescents who have been diagnosed with autism and who are at 12 13 least 15 years of age and not more than 18 years of age. The homes shall be located in 3 separate geographical areas of the 14 15 State. The homes shall operate 7 days per week and shall be

staffed 24 hours per day. The homes shall feature maximum

- family involvement based on a service and support agreement

 signed by the adolescent's family and the provider. An eligible

 service provider: (i) must have a minimum of 5 years experience
- 4 <u>serving individuals with autism residentially and have</u>
- 5 <u>successfully supported individuals with challenging behaviors;</u>
- 6 <u>(ii) must demonstrate that staff have equal experience in this</u>
- 7 regard; and (iii) must have a full-time Board-Certified
- 8 <u>Behavior Analyst on staff.</u>
- 9 <u>(b) The provider shall ensure that the staff at each home</u>
 10 <u>receives appropriate training in matters that include, but need</u>
- not be limited to, the following: behavior analysis, skill
- 12 <u>training</u>, and other methodologies of teaching such as discreet
- trial and picture exchange communication system.
- 14 (c) The homes shall provide therapeutic and other support
- services to the adolescents being served there. The therapeutic
- 16 <u>curriculum shall be based on the principles of applied behavior</u>
- 17 analysis.
- 18 <u>(d) An agreeable rate shall be established by the</u>
- 19 Department of Children and Family Services and the Department
- of Human Services, Developmental Disabilities Division.
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 22 2007.".
