Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a municipality with a population of 1,000,000 or more may enact an ordinance to allow companion dogs in outdoor areas of restaurants where food is served. Defines "companion dog".

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
Section 11-20-14 as follows:

7 11-20-14. Companion dogs; restaurants. Sec. Notwithstanding any other prohibition to the contrary, a 8 9 municipality with a population of 1,000,000 or more may, by 10 ordinance, authorize the presence of companion dogs in outdoor areas of restaurants where food is served, if the ordinance 11 12 provides for adequate controls to ensure compliance with the Illinois Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, the Food Handling 13 14 Regulation Enforcement Act, the Sanitary Food Preparation Act, and any other applicable statutes and ordinances. An ordinance 15 16 enacted under this Section shall provide that: (i) no companion 17 dog shall be present in the interior of any restaurant or in any area where food is prepared; and (ii) the restaurant shall 18 19 have the right to refuse to serve the owner of a companion dog 20 if the owner fails to exercise reasonable control over the 21 companion dog or the companion dog is otherwise behaving in a 22 manner that compromises or threatens to compromise the health or safety of any person present in the restaurant, including, 23
