## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
- 5 Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by adding Section

- 8 Sec. 54.5. Rates; community-based residential programs for
- 9 persons with developmental disabilities.
- 10 <u>(a) The General Assembly finds that, due to economic</u>
- 11 <u>factors, it has become increasingly necessary for providers of</u>
- 12 <u>residential</u> <u>services</u> to <u>persons</u> <u>with</u> <u>developmental</u>
- disabilities to expand the number of persons with developmental
- 14 <u>disabilities living together in community-based residential</u>
- programs funded by the Department. The General Assembly further
- finds that, in order to enhance opportunities for persons with
- 17 <u>developmental disabilities to live in the community with</u>
- dignity and individual privacy, and to maximize the benefits of
- 19 <u>the supportive services provided in community-based</u>
- 20 <u>residential programs, it is necessary and appropriate to offer</u>
- 21 <u>financial incentives to providers so that they can establish</u>
- 22 <u>community-based residential programs of 4 or fewer individuals</u>
- 23 living together.

- (b) As used in this Section, "community-based residential program" means one of a variety of living arrangements for persons with developmental disabilities, including existing settings, such as community integrated living arrangements, community residential alternatives, assisted residential care, supported residential care, and adult foster care, and may also include newly developed settings that are consistent with this definition. The term "developmental disability" includes an autism spectrum disorder.
- (c) The Department of Human Services shall establish reimbursement rates that will create an incentive for providers to establish community-based residential programs in which no more than 4 persons with developmental disabilities reside together and in which each person has his or her own individual private bedroom.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 16 17 becoming law.
