1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
14-6.10 as follows:

Sec. 14-6.10. Transfer of parental rights at the age of
majority.

9 (a) When a student who is eligible for special education under this Article reaches the majority age of 18 years, all 10 rights accorded to the student's parents under this Article 11 transfer to the student, except as provided in this Section. 12 This transfer of rights also applies to students who are 13 14 incarcerated in an adult or juvenile State or local correctional institution. Nothing in this Section shall be 15 16 construed to deny a student with a disability who has reached 17 majority age the right to have an adult of his or her choice, including, but not limited to, the student's parent, assist the 18 19 student in making decisions regarding the student's 20 individualized education program.

21 (b) The school district must notify the student and the 22 student's parents of the transfer of rights in writing at a 23 meeting convened to review the student's individualized SB0396 Engrossed - 2 - LRB095 08193 NHT 28361 b

education program during the school year in which the student turns 17 years of age. At that time, the school district must provide the student with a copy of the Delegation of Rights form described in this Section. The school district must mail the notice and a copy of the Delegation of Rights form to the student and to the student's parents, addressed to their last known address, if they do not attend the meeting.

8 (c) Rights shall not transfer from the parents to the 9 student under this Section if either of the following apply:

10 <u>(1) The student with a disability who has reached the</u> 11 <u>age of majority has been adjudged incompetent under State</u> 12 law.

13 (2) The student has not been adjudged incompetent under 14 State law, but the student has executed a Delegation of 15 Rights to make educational decisions pursuant to this 16 Section for the purpose of appointing the student's parent 17 or other adult to represent the educational interests of 18 the student.

A student may terminate the Delegation of Rights at any time and assume the right to make decisions regarding his or her education. The Delegation of Rights shall meet all of the following requirements:

(A) It shall remain in effect for one year after the
 date of execution, but may be renewed annually with the
 written or other formal authorization of the student and
 the person the student delegates to represent the

1	educational interests of the student.
2	(B) It shall be signed by the student or verified by
3	other means, such as audio or video or other alternative
4	format compatible with the student's disability showing
5	that the student has agreed to the terms of the delegation.
6	(C) It shall be signed or otherwise manifest
7	verification that the designee accepts the delegation.
8	(D) It shall include declarations that the student (i)
9	is 18 years of age or older, (ii) intends to delegate his
10	or her educational rights under federal and State law to a
11	specified individual who is at least 18 years of age, (iii)
12	has not been adjudged incompetent under State law, (iv) is
13	entitled to be present during the development of the
14	student's individualized education program and to raise
15	issues or concerns about the student's individualized
16	education program, (v) will be permitted to terminate the
17	Delegation of Rights at any time, and (vi) will notify the
18	school district immediately if the student terminates the
19	Delegation of Rights.
20	(E) It shall be identical or substantially the same as
21	the following form:
22	DELEGATION OF RIGHTS TO MAKE EDUCATIONAL DECISION

under State and federal law. I have not been adjudged 1 2 incompetent and, as of the date of the execution of this 3 document, I hereby delegate my right to give consent and make 4 decisions concerning my education to (insert name), who will be 5 considered my "parent" for purposes of the Individuals with 6 Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 and Article 14 7 of the School Code and will exercise all of the rights and 8 responsibilities concerning my education that are conferred on 9 a parent under those laws. I understand and give my consent for 10 (insert name) to make all decisions relating to my education on 11 my behalf. I understand that I have the right to be present at 12 meetings held to develop my individualized education program 13 and that I have the right to raise any issues or concerns I may 14 have and that the school district must consider them.

15 This delegation will be in effect for one year from the 16 date of execution below and may be renewed by my written or 17 other formal authorization. I also understand that I have the right to terminate this Delegation of Rights at any time and 18 19 assume the right to make my own decisions regarding my 20 education. I understand that I must notify the school district 21 immediately if I revoke this Delegation of Rights prior to its 22 expiration.
