### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

205 ILCS 670/12.5

Amends the Consumer Installment Loan Act. Provides that a licensee may maintain a limited purpose branch for the sole purpose of making loans as permitted by the Act (now, a licensee is required to have the written approval of the Director of Financial Institutions).

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Consumer Installment Loan Act is amended by
changing Section 12.5 as follows:

6 (205 ILCS 670/12.5)

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Sec. 12.5. Limited purpose branch.

8 (a) <u>A</u> Upon the written approval of the Director, a licensee 9 may maintain a limited purpose branch for the sole purpose of 10 making loans as permitted by this Act. A limited purpose branch 11 may include an automatic loan machine. No other activity shall 12 be conducted at the site, including but not limited to, 13 accepting payments, servicing the accounts, or collections.

(b) The licensee must submit an application for a limited purpose branch to the Director on forms prescribed by the Director with an application fee of \$300. The approval for the limited purpose branch must be renewed concurrently with the renewal of the licensee's license along with a renewal fee of \$300 for the limited purpose branch.

(c) The books, accounts, records, and files of the limited purpose branch's transactions shall be maintained at the licensee's licensed location. The licensee shall notify the Director of the licensed location at which the books, accounts, - 2 - LRB095 09982 MJR 30196 b

1 records, and files shall be maintained.

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2 (d) The licensee shall prominently display at the limited 3 purpose branch the address and telephone number of the 4 licensee's licensed location.

5 (e) No other business shall be conducted at the site of the
6 limited purpose branch unless authorized by the Director.

7 (f) The Director shall make and enforce reasonable rules8 for the conduct of a limited purpose branch.

9 (g) A limited purpose branch may not be located within 10 1,000 feet of a facility operated by an inter-track wagering 11 licensee or an organization licensee subject to the Illinois 12 Horse Racing Act of 1975, on a riverboat subject to the 13 Riverboat Gambling Act, or within 1,000 feet of the location at 14 which the riverboat docks.
