1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3-100 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-100) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-100)
- 7 Sec. 3-100. Definitions. For the the purposes of this
- 8 Chapter, the following words shall have the meanings ascribed
- 9 to them:
- 10 "Electronic" includes electrical, digital, magnetic,
- optical, electromagnetic, or any other form of technology that
- 12 entails capabilities similar to these technologies.
- "Electronic record" means a record generated,
- 14 communicated, received, or stored by electronic means for use
- in an information system or for transmission from one
- information system to another.
- "Electronic signature" means a signature in electronic
- 18 form attached to or logically associated with an electronic
- 19 record.
- "Owner" means a person who holds legal document of
- 21 ownership of a vehicle, limited to a certificate of origin,
- 22 certificate of title, salvage certificate, or junking
- certificate. However, in the event a vehicle is the subject of

an agreement for the conditional sale or lease thereof with the

- 9 "Record" means information that is inscribed, stored, or 10 otherwise fixed on a tangible medium or that is stored in an 11 electronic or other medium and is retrievable in perceivable
- 12 form.
- "Signature" or "signed" includes any symbol executed or
- 14 adopted, or any security procedure employed or adopted, using
- electronic means or otherwise, by or on behalf of a person with
- intent to authenticate a record.
