The Department of Human Services Act is amended 4 by adding Section 10-33 as follows: 5 6 (20 ILCS 1305/10-33 new)7 Sec. 10-33. Sexual assault education program. (a) The Department shall conduct a comprehensive study of 8

the needs of women with disabilities who reside in the community as well as structured living environments regarding sexual assault and the threat of sexual violence. The study must include a needs assessment during the first year that gathers input from women with disabilities, service providers, and advocacy organizations. This study must inform the development and implementation of educational programs for women with disabilities, including distribution of information
