Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Attorney General Act is amended by changing

- 7 Sec. 4b. Before the filing of the first pleading in
- 8 federal district court in any civil action brought by the
- 9 Attorney General in the name of the State as parens patriae on
- 10 behalf of the natural persons residing in this State, as
- 11 authorized by Section 4c of the Clayton Act, 15 U.S.C.A 15c,
- 12 the Attorney General shall file with the Auditor General a
- 13 statement disclosing the fee arrangements applicable to the
- 14 attorneys' fees in relation to that civil action.
